The themes for the remainder of the year are:

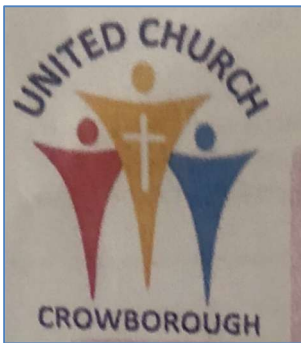
